School Profile

Woodland Christian Middle School is the grade 6-8 component of Woodland Christian School (k-12), and is the bridge between the self-contained elementary classroom and the departmentalized high school. At WCMS, students develop the academic and social skills necessary to excel in high school and beyond by engaging in challenging curriculum and exciting extracurricular activities. A Biblical worldview is integral to our instruction; through weekly chapels, Bible class, and relationships with faculty and one another, students are supported and encouraged to grow in their faith.

WCMS is a dually accredited member of the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI), and WASC (Western Association of School and Colleges). Our staff includes 1 principal, 1 administrative secretary, 1 assistant secretary, 9 full-time teachers, and 2 IT support specialists. We begin the 2015-2016 school year with 151 total students. Average class size is 21 students, with a cap set at 26 students per class section.
